

Clear Retainer Instructions



What a Clear Retainers does:

- 1. Maintain the alignment of the teeth and bite and prevent shifting from occurring
- 2. Prevents premature tooth wear from grinding or clenching teeth while sleeping

Important Considerations:

- 1. Wear clear retainers as prescribed by the doctor
- 2. Keep retainers in the case provided when not in your mouth
- 3. Let us know immediately if retainers are lost, broken or do not fit properly. We want to ensure you have a well fitting retainer to prevent shifting of your teeth
- 4. Remove retainers while eating, drinking and playing sports
- 5. Use a toothbrush and water and dish soap to clean retainers, avoid using toothpaste as it can make retainers less clear.
- 6. Use denture cleaning tablets to disinfect retainers as needed (typically every 2 weeks)
- 7. Keep retainers away from extreme temperatures
- 8. Keep retainers away from pets (dogs love to chew retainers)
- 9. Initial retainers are included with your treatment, but there is a fee to replace lost or broken retainers

Advantages Clear Retainers:

- 1. They are nearly invisible and do an excellent job in keeping your teeth straight
- 2. If you follow our instructions for lifetime wear, you will have straight teeth for life!
