

## **Maxillary Expander Instructions**



Turning Protocol: 2x/day for the 1st week 1x/day for the following 2 weeks (28 turns total over 3 weeks)

## What a Maxillary Expander does:

1. A Maxillary Expander widens the upper jaw to improve the bite and increase space for alignment or eruption of permanent teeth.

## **Important Considerations:**

- 1. A maxillary expander does not cause pain.
- 2. It takes 4-7 days to become accustomed to eating and speaking with the expander.
- 3. A milkshake or smoothie after placement can help with getting used to swallowing with the tongue in a slightly different position.
- 4. Many video resources are available online that demonstrate how to properly (turn/activate) the expander.
- 5. Space will develop between the upper front teeth during expansion. This is normal and is a sign that expansion is successful.
- 6. Maxillary expanders are kept in place typically for 9-12 months to allow the bones of the upper jaw to stabilize after expansion.

## **Advantages of a Maxillary Expander:**

- 1. Since the maxillary expander is fixed in place, it is always working. The patient does not have to worry about taking a removable appliance in or out of their mouth.
- 2. It helps to improve the skeletal structure of the upper jaw, allowing for improved growth and development.
- 3. It improves smile esthetics and the function of the bite.
- 4. It can prevent the future need for jaw surgery or permanent tooth extraction in some patients.
