

## Removable Expander Instructions



Turning Protocol: 1 turn 2x/week (every 3-4 days)

## What a Removable Expander does:

- 1. A Removable Expander widens the arch to create more space for the alignment or eruption of permanent teeth.
- 2. It improves the functional relationship of the upper and lower teeth.

## **Important Considerations:**

- 1. Prescribed turns (activations) to the expander are done with the expander out of the mouth and with a specific key for turning.
- 2. It is important to place the expander in the case provided when it is not in the mouth.
- 3. If the expander does not fit properly, stop turns, continue wearing, and see if the fit improves after 2-3 days. If the fit does not improve, please contact the office to schedule an appointment.
- 4. The expander will work very well if it is worn as directed.

## Advantages of a Removable Expander:

- 1. It can be removed from the mouth putting the patient in control.
- 2. It may prevent the future need for jaw surgery or permanent tooth extraction in some patients.
