

Separators



What separators do:

- 1. Separators relieve contact between teeth in preparation for a banded appliance
- 2. Allow for easier insertion of the banded appliance at delivery

Important Considerations:

- 1. Separators begin the process of tooth movement and may cause mild discomfort
- 2. Soreness is usually mild and decreases significantly after 2 days
- 3. Take Motrin or Tylenol as directed on the bottle as needed for discomfort
- 4. Avoid extremely sticky foods such as taffy and caramels while the separators are inserted
- 5. Do not floss where the separators are in place
- 6. If a separator comes out, it is not a problem and does not need to be replaced. The separator likely came out because there is adequate space between the teeth
- 7. Separators are non-toxic and will not harm the GI system if swallowed accidentally
